



## Billye Ruth (Williams) Huchton

Billye was born on October 1, 1922 at Salona, Montague County, Texas to Calvin L. and Estelle (Stella) May Campbell Williams. She graduated from Ryan High School, Ryan Oklahoma in 1940. Billye traveled to Oregon in 1943 to marry John F. Huchton who had been drafted into the army and was then in basic training at Fort Ord. After his Honorable Discharge from the army for health reasons, the couple made their home in California until the end of World War II when they returned to Muenster to raise their family. Billye enjoyed working in the public sphere, and had a long career in retail sales: B&B Sales in Gainesville, Inlook Outlet in Muenster and Gainesville, and Crafty Ole German in Muenster. Her favorite hobbies were sewing clothing for her children and grandchildren and reading the newspapers. Most of her life was spent in Muenster, but during her long illness, she lived in a care facility in Denton, Texas, where she died on October 13, 2024.
