She moved to Azle, TX in 2005 to be closer to Linda and Dale. She and Clark loved to garden, and she always had something sweet cooked and ready to be served to visiting family and friends. She loved to laugh and stories were told of excessive giggling in Wal-Mart and Dr.'s waiting rooms.

Even though she was born in the depression era, she said she never knew she was poor. She touched so many lives in her 100 plus years and April 9, 2024 was designated Charlene Lyons Day by Proclamation of the Office of Alan Brundrett, mayor of Azle, TX.
