Charles "Charlie" Arthur Taylor was born on September 15, 1942. Charlie passed away on March 20, 2026. Funeral services will be conducted by Steve Chism and Tim Cole and will be held on Tuesday, March 24, 2026, at the Saint Jo Church of Christ at 2:00 PM.
