He enjoyed spending time with the family, especially his grandkids. Nothing meant more to him than taking them for rides on the tractor or taking walks through the creek enjoying nature. Being true to his

nickname, Speedy would challenge the kids to a foot race...a barefoot race! This even happened just a few weeks ago.

He could often be found playing dominoes at the VFW. His favorite domino partner was Butch Fisher. Speedy was well known around town for making the best pizza burgers ever. He could often be seen wearing his hat with the bill flipped up. He never met a stranger. Just a brief time spent with him, felt like you were old friends, cutting up and telling jokes.
