



## Roy Lawler

November 12, 1925 - May 11, 2017

Funeral service for Roy Lawler, age 91 of Saint Jo were held at 2:00 PM, Saturday, May 13, 2017 at First United Methodist Church in Saint Jo and officiated by Rev. Larry Coleman and Rev. E. Sam Campbell. Burial followed in Mountain Park Cemetery in Saint Jo. Services were under the direction of Scott Funeral Home in Saint Jo. Mr. Lawler died Thursday, May 11, 2017.

Roy William Lawler was born November 12, 1925 to Carroll (A.C.) and Pearl (Lawson) Lawler. He was one of their five children. Roy married the love of his life, Mary Faye Dunn on February 9, 1947. They were the proud parents of one son, Roy William Lawler, Jr.

Roy served his country in the United States Navy during World War II achieving the rank of Pharmacist's Mate, Third Class.
