



## Sandra Kay (Gregory) Thurman

April 23, 1936 - September 8, 2023

Sandra Kay Gregory Thurman, 87, passed away Friday, September 8, 2023, in Nocona, Texas.

A funeral service was held at 10:00 am, Tuesday, September 12, 2023, at First Baptist Church in Saint Jo, Texas with Pastor Mark McBride officiating. Interment followed at Mountain Park Cemetery in Saint Jo.

Mrs. Thurman was born on April 23, 1936, to Calaway and Eloise Kavanaugh Gregory in Palm Springs, California. Her father was a paint contractor and died when he accidentally fell from scaffolding while painting. After her father's death in 1938, Sandra and her mother moved to Saint Jo, Texas, where her mother married Cecil Bellah and their family ran a local dry goods store on the square. She attended school in Saint Jo and graduated in 1954. She married Delmer Sewell and together they were married 57 years and raised their 3 children. After Mr. Sewell's death, Sandra attended a class reunion in Saint Jo and was reunited with Larry Thurman, a former classmate and friend. She and Larry were married on December 22, 2012, in Las Cruces, New Mexico, and enjoyed 10 years of marriage together.

Sandra was a homemaker and a school secretary. She loved to sing and even sang on the radio while she was in high school. She was voted Best Personality while she was in high school. Sandra loved to travel and spend time with Larry. She enjoyed reading her Bible and attending church. She also enjoyed working in the yard and decorating. She would often say that she enjoyed decorating the yard for holidays so those that couldn't be home with their families would be able to enjoy the holiday decorations.

Mrs. Thurman is survived by her husband Larry of the home; children: Daniel Hollis Sewell, Lisa Sewell Lebovitz, Robert Douglas Sewell; stepchildren: Patrick Thurman and Linda Thurman, and her sister Raima Bellah; and 4 grandchildren and 3 step-grandchildren.

Mrs. Thurman was preceded in death by her parents and her sisters, Norma Gregory and Rossie Bellah.
