Pauline (Davenport) Parker, age 90, passed to her heavenly home, Saturday, April 4, 2020. Due to the Coronavirus restrictions, a private family graveside service will be held at Illinois Bend Cemetery with Reverend Paul McQuerry, grandson, officiating on Tuesday, April 7, 2020. The service will be under the direction of Scott Funeral Home of Saint Jo.

Pauline was born on February 17, 1930 in Love County, Oklahoma to Opal (Lyons) and Otto Davenport who preceded her in death. She had one brother, Clinton Doyle Davenport, who died in infancy.
